ALPHABET LETTERS

We have been reviewing letters E-H, along with the letter sounds.

We have also been reviewing letters A-H, and Upper/Lowercase

NUMBERS

Students have been learning numbers 5-8 and the amount within these numbers.

students have also been reviewing numbers 1-8 and the amount of each.

SHAPES

Students have been practicing to identify shapes and pronounce/recall these words: rectangle, square, triangle, oval, trapezoid, pentagon, octagon, hexagon, diamond, and circle

We have been practicing pronouncing and recalling vocabulary words that we have learned so far with the letters of the week.
