


WHAT WE HAVE ###THIS MONTH:::

In our bucket

Theme: Environmental adaptation and things around me.

<u>Literacy</u>: Letter recognition, Phonological awareness, Auditory Perception and Discrimination (APD), Mindfulness Journal - to help children to build self awareness and express their feelings in a healthy way.

Numeracy: Attributes, Properties, Groupings, Bridges, Patterns, Attributes of Shapes, Figurative Counting, and Number Sequence. (Logic)

<u>Social Studies</u>: Appreciation of individual differences and similarities. Students will explore how they are similar and different to others. They will reflect on how their differences make them unique.

Physical Education: Care for one's own health and safety. We will learn fun ways to practice mindfulness and balance, how to eat well or keep clean and hygienic.
