Literacy

Children are continuing their learning journey with phonics, specifically focusing on Sound Q, R, S, T, U. Their vocabulary is expanding, and they are honing their sound recognition skills.

Numeracy

We've been working on graphs, shapes, patterns, subtraction and addition, and we'll continue to focus on these topics for the rest of the month to ensure a solid understanding.

UOI

This month's Unit of Inquiry focuses on the theme of "How We Express Ourselves," where we'll continue exploring different cultures. We look forward to learning about various cultural expressions till the end of the month

Here are some ways you can support your child's learning journey at home:

- Play "I Spy" with sounds (Q, R, S, T, U) & read simple books. Say a word, ask "What sound does it start with?". Start reading words in books by sounding out the letter.
- Numeracy: Count everyday (stairs, toys) & find ways to explore addition and subtraction at home.

UOI: Discuss cultures, focusing on the cultural practices you engage in at home, such as holidays or festivals
