## UOI

This month's Unit of Inquiry focuses on the theme of "How We Express Ourselves," where we'll be exploring different cultures. We look forward to learning about various cultural expressions throughout the month.

Here are some ways you can support your child's learning journey at home:

- Play "I Spy" with sounds (Q, R, S, T, U) & read simple books. Say a word, ask "What sound does it start with?". Start reading words in books by sounding out the letter.
- Numeracy: Count everyday (stairs, toys) & find ways to explore addition and subtraction at home.

UOI: Discuss cultures, focusing on the cultural practices you engage in at home, such as holidays or festivals
