Literacy

In December, we will complete our phonics lessons by finishing with the letter Z. The children have begun learning to read CVC words and practicing blending sounds. Once phonics is complete, our focus will shift to strengthening their skills in reading and working with CVC words.

Numeracy

We've been working on graphs, shapes, patterns, subtraction and addition, and we'll continue to focus on these topics for the rest of the month to ensure a solid understanding.

UOI

Next month's Unit of Inquiry will focus on the theme "How We Express Ourselves." We'll explore how we can express our identities and emotions using a combination of colors, symbols, and words.

Here are some ways you can support your child's learning journey at home:

Literacy: Review phonics and practice blending letters to create simple words. Encourage your child to sound out and read words in books, focusing on CVC words.

Numeracy: Practice counting in everyday situations, such as counting stairs or toys, and explore simple addition and subtraction through fun activities at home.

Unit of Inquiry: Explore how your family expresses themselves. Discuss activities where you use art, music, colors, or symbols to share your thoughts and emotions. Try creative projects, sing favorite songs, or reflect on family routines that showcase how you express your unique identity.
