Literacy

The children will be learning the letters E, F, G, and H this month for phonics

Numeracy

This month, we will focus on counting up to 20, developing number recognition, and exploring simple patterns.

Theme

This month, our focus will be on 'Plants and Animals'—we'll be exploring what they need and how to care for them.

Here are some ways you can reinforce your child's learning at home:

- Numeracy: Practice recognizing numbers around the house—like on clocks, doors, or even license plates—to help your child become more confident identifying numbers up to 20.
- Literacy: Focus on sounding out the letters E (/e/ as in "elephant"), F (/f/ as in "fish"), G (/g/ as in "goat"), and H (/h/ as in "hat"). Say words together that begin with each sound, and encourage your child to sound out simple words phonetically.
- Theme ("Plants and Animals"): Support your child's learning by talking about what plants and animals need to grow—like sunlight, water, food, and care. Encourage them to observe plants or animals at home, or take a walk outside to notice how they grow and change.
