

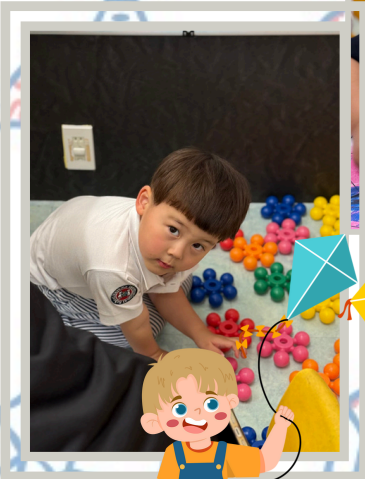
B5 Classroom Newsletter
