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Math - Counting by 1s & 2s

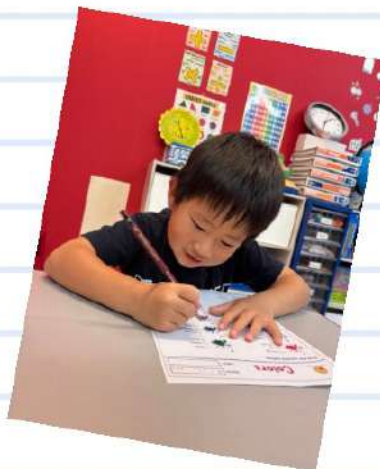
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Colorful Learning

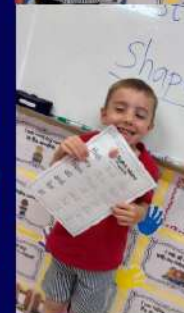
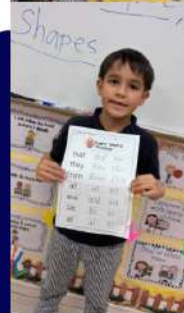
