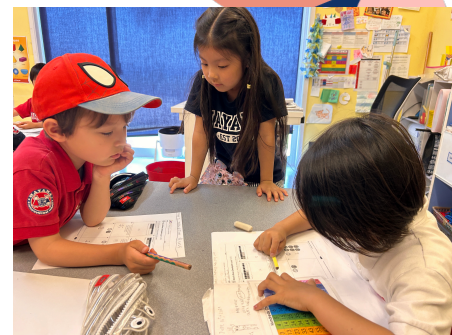
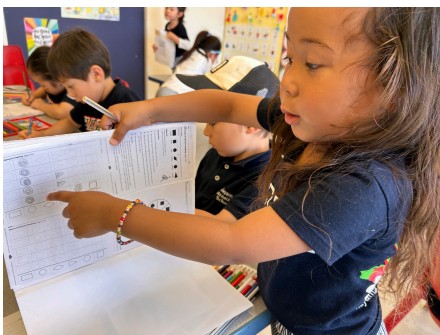
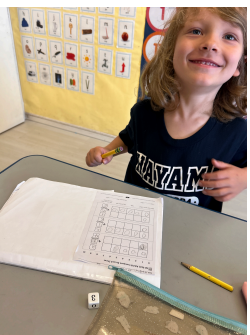

# What Are We Doing

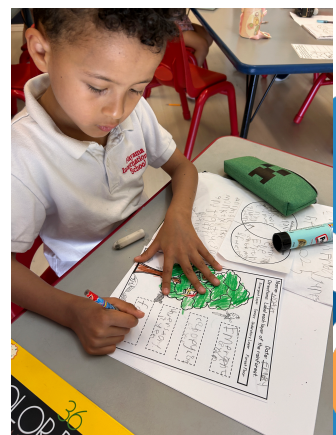
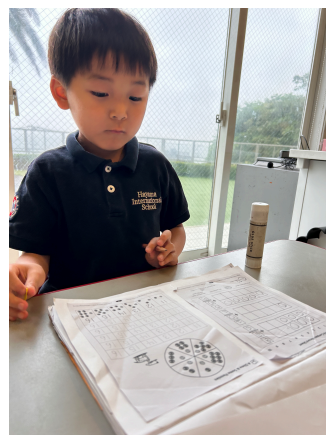
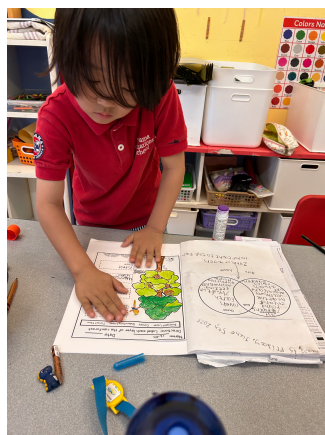
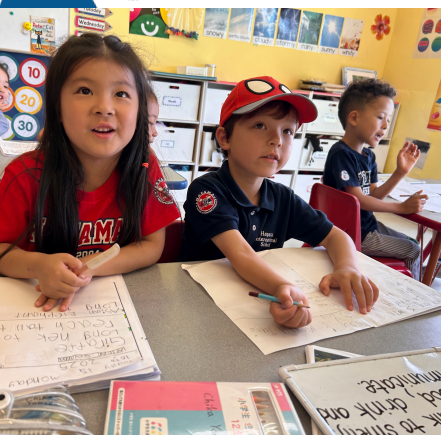
## Math

## U.O.I

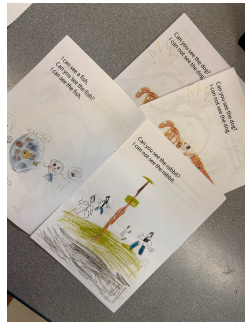
Exploring the rainforest and then the ocean, we discuss the visual clues we can identify to make assumptions about how, where, and why the animals live and look the way they do.





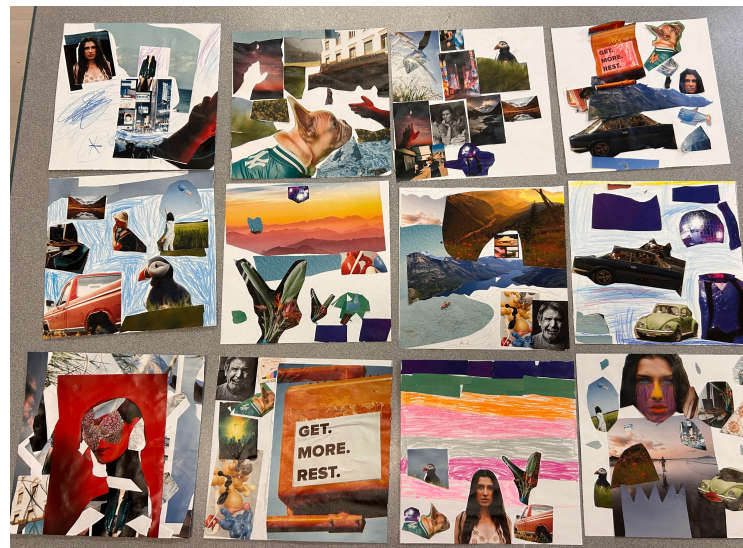
# Language Arts
