Literacy

The children will learn the letters I, J, K, and L this month during phonics.

Numeracy

This month, we will continue working on counting up to 20, developing number recognition, and exploring simple patterns.

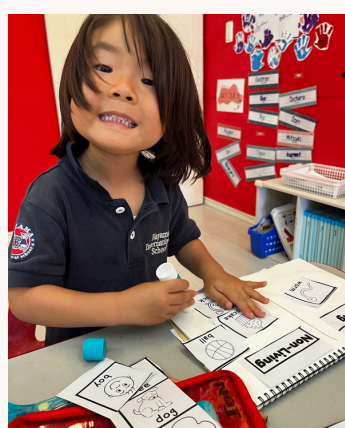
Theme

This month, we will continue focusing on 'Plants and Animals'—learning how to care for them and exploring the differences between living and non-living things.

Numeracy: Continue practicing number recognition by pointing out numbers up to 20 in your daily surroundings—on clocks, calendars, or packaging. You can also create simple patterns together using toys, blocks, or drawings.

Literacy: Help your child learn the sounds of the letters I (/i/ as in "insect"), J (/j/ as in "jelly"), K (/k/ as in "kite"), and L (/l/ as in "lion"). Try saying words together that begin with each sound and encourage your child to find objects around the house that start with these letters.

Theme ("Plants and Animals"): Talk about how we care for plants and animals—giving them food, water, and attention. You can also help your child explore the difference between living and non-living things by looking at items around the house or outside and asking, "Is this alive?" and "Why or why not?"
