Literacy

This month, the children learned the letters I, J, K, and L. They practiced identifying each letter, learning their phonetic sounds, and saying words that begin with these letters.

Numeracy

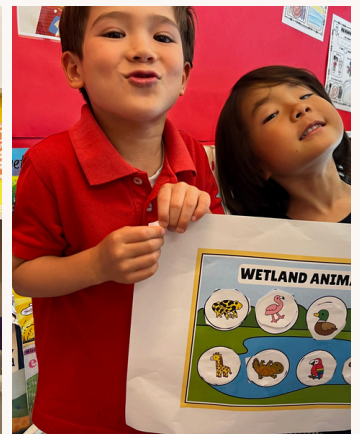
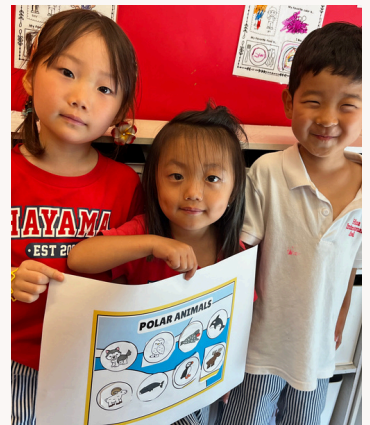
The children continued working on counting up to 20, number recognition, and recognizing simple patterns.

Theme

This month, our theme was "Plants and Animals." The children explored what living things need to grow—such as sunlight, water, food, and care—and learned how to take care of them.

Ways to support learning at home:

- **Literacy:** Help your child review the sounds of the letters I, J, K, and L by saying words that begin with those letters (e.g., insect, jelly, kite, lion). Practice identifying the letters in books or signs around the home.
- **Numeracy:** Encourage your child to recognize numbers up to 20 in daily life—on clocks, doors, or calendars. Create patterns using toys or household items to reinforce what they've learned.
- **Theme – Plants and Animals:** Talk with your child about what plants and animals need to live and grow. Take time to observe nature together—whether it's watering a plant at home or looking at animals in your neighborhood or a nearby park.
