## Language Arts:

We introduced the letters Ii and Jj. The children made letter crafts: I is for Iguana and J is for Jaguar. We also colored pictures of items that begin with the letters I and J, and practiced identifying these letters in words and in our own names.

## Mathematics

We explored numbers 9 and 10, and learned about shapes like pentagons and ovals. The children practiced counting the letters in their names and counted 9–10 animals.

## Social Studies:

Identifying Feelings: sad and surprised. Children who know how to identify emotions tend to have better social skills and be less aggressive and more accepted by peers.
