Language Arts:

This week, we focused on the letter Hh and reviewed letters Ee, Ff, Gg, and Hh. To support letter recognition in a fun and engaging way, we created zoo animal crafts such as a Hungry Hippo, Goby Fish, Gorilla, and Hedgehog. Our letter craft for H was a Horse. We also played various games to reinforce learning. A class favorite was the jumping game using large gum tape letters placed on the floor, making it both active and educational.

Social Studies:

Identifying Feelings:

Happy

This week, we focused on the feeling happy. Learning to identify emotions helps children develop stronger social skills, reduces aggressive behavior, and supports positive peer relationships.

Science : Sense of hearing.

We explored various animal sounds this week, inspired by the coloring book Polar Bear, Polar Bear, What Do You Hear? The children enjoyed identifying each animal by its sound, helping to develop their listening skills and sound recognition.

We engaged in a fun activity to explore the sense of smell, trying out different scents and discussing whether we liked them or not. This helped children express their preferences and build sensory awareness
