ALPHABETS

Students have been enthusiastically exploring the world of letters and their sounds, with a special focus on H last week, while revisiting E, F, G, and H for this week. As they dive into phonics, they are not only enhancing their understanding of letter sounds but also expanding their vocabulary from A to Z. Practicing it with fun activities, worksheets, and creative crafts. The children delight in the engaging melodies of songs like "Fun with Phonics" by Pinkfong and "Alphabet Chant" by Super Simple, making their learning experience both enjoyable and memorable.

SHAPES

Students have been learning about shapes, including triangles, circles, and squares, through tracing and coloring worksheets. We are now beginning to explore more shapes, such as rectangles, ovals, crosses, arrows, hearts, stars, diamonds, trapezoids, decagons, pentagons, hexagons, octagons, and heptagons. We are leveling up the shape activity with a "Find the Peer" card game. In this activity, students will not only identify shapes but also apply their knowledge of numbers and colors to match the dictated cards.



NUMBERS

Students have been learning the numbers 1 to 10, with a particular focus on 7, 8, and 9. We are practicing tracing the numbers from 1 to 7 and identifying their corresponding quantities through tracing, counting exercises, and songs. They are gradually becoming proficient in counting from 1 to 20 by singing along with the song "Walrus."
