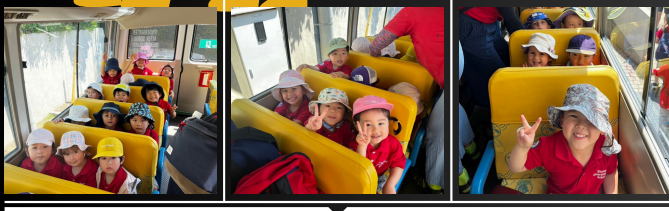
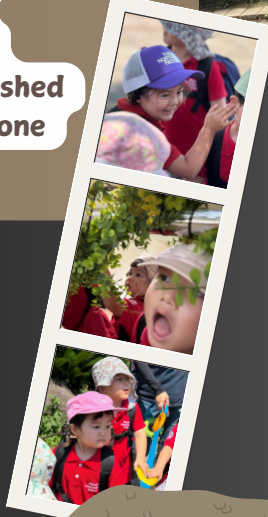

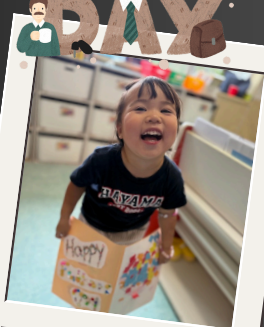
Every Wednesday, we have a new counting song for the kids to listen to. They enjoy interacting with the song and singing along.
