

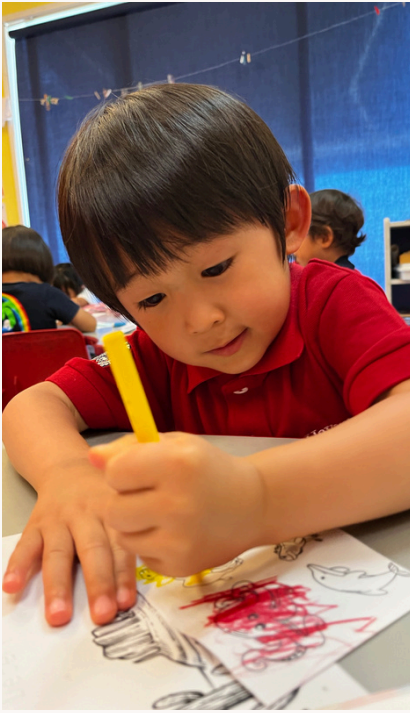

Literacy

This month, the children learned up to the letter N. They practiced identifying each letter, learning their phonetic sounds, and saying words that begin with these letters.

Numeracy

The children continued working on counting up to 20, number recognition, and recognizing simple patterns.

Theme

This month, we finished our theme on “Plants and Animals” and started a new theme on the senses. The children explored the different senses and how we use them to experience the world around us.

Literacy: Help your child review the sounds of the letters I, J, K, L, M, and N by saying words that begin with those letters (e.g., insect, jelly, kite, lion, monkey, nest). Practice identifying the letters in books, signs, or labels around the home.

Numeracy: Encourage your child to recognize numbers up to 20 in daily life—on clocks, doors, or calendars. Create simple patterns using toys or household items to reinforce what they’ve learned.

Theme – Plants, Animals, and Senses: Talk with your child about what plants and animals need to live and grow. Observe nature together—whether it’s watering a plant at home or spotting animals in your neighborhood or park. You can also explore the five senses by asking questions like, What do you hear? What can you smell? How does this feel? during everyday activities.
