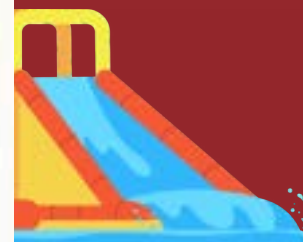

# ART

In this unit, Grade 5 and 6 students explored abstract art inspired by Wassily Kandinsky and Joan Miró. They learned how to express emotions and ideas through composition, using both organic and geometric shapes. Students experimented with line, color, and form to create dynamic, expressive pieces. They drew on aluminum foil with permanent markers, which offered a unique reflective surface and encouraged creative risk-taking. This project helped them understand how abstract art can communicate feelings and stories beyond realistic representation, while building confidence in their artistic voice.

Ms. Momoko gave a special lesson where she shared her experiences as a cabin crew member for Jetstar. She talked about the different countries she visited, what it was like working on an airplane, and how she helped passengers during flights. The students were very curious and excited to learn more. 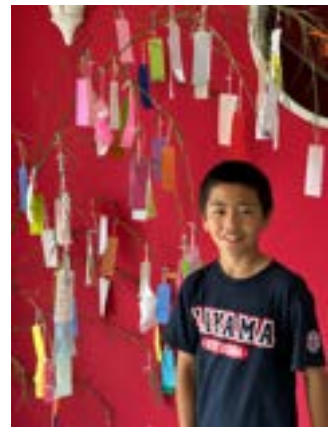
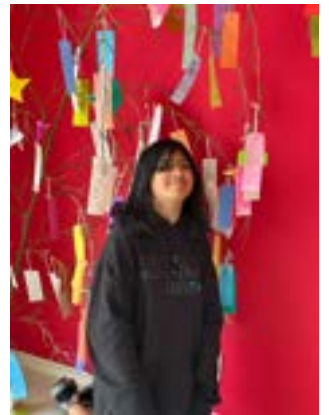
