Previous Weeks Academic

Alphabet and Language Arts

Students focus on learning the letters K and L. The instruction includes practicing the sounds, figures, and vocabulary associated with these letters. A comprehensive review from A to L is conducted through tracing the letters, engaging with sounds, songs, and crafts.

Furthermore, phonics and alphabet recall are reinforced via enjoyable activities and songs, making it an integral part of daily routines. This approach encourages students to practice English through storytelling and conversations, even during lunchtime, fostering a natural learning environment.

SHAPES

Students are exploring various shapes, primarily focusing on the circle, square, oval, star, triangle, rectangle, heart, and pentagon.

Additionally, they are reviewing other shapes such as rectangles, crosses, arrows, hearts, stars, diamonds, trapezoids, decagons, hexagons, octagons, and heptagons. To make the activity more engaging, we are incorporating fun songs about shapes. The students are enjoying new tunes like "I Like to Draw" by Super Simple, "Dance with Shapes" by Singing Walrus, and "I'm a Shape" from Sing and Learn.

NUMBERS

Students have been focusing on the numbers 11 and 12, practicing their counting skills through oral recitation and shape activities. As the week concludes, they are reviewing numbers from 1 to 12 to reinforce their understanding.

Additionally, the children are engaging in enjoyable activities and songs that cover counting up to 100. A favorite among them is the "Counting by Tens" song featuring a Singing Walrus, which they love due to its catchy rhythm.
