- Through arts and self-expression, they connected learning to real life by writing about friendship ("I like my friend because we...") and illustrating their ideas, then presenting their work to the class.

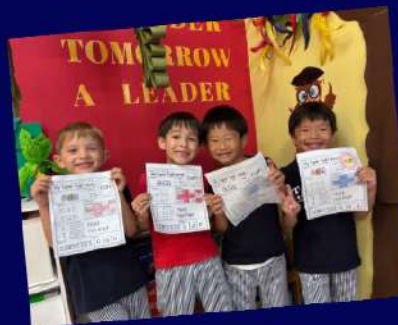
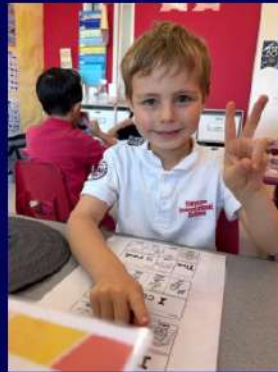
