

### **CASSROOM ACTIVITIES**

### **Phonics Activities**

This term, our A3 students also strengthened their pronunciation skills by learning the phonics sounds /c/ and /k/. Through lively songs, fun chants, and picture cards, the children explored words beginning with these sounds. For C, they practiced saying words like carrot, cap, candy, and cat, while for K, they enjoyed knight, kite, knee, king, kitten, kettle, and kid. The children were eager to repeat the sounds, act them out, and connect them with real-life objects. This activity not only improved their articulation but also built their confidence in recognizing and using new sounds in everyday words.

Our students enjoyed an engaging lesson on Community Helpers where they learned about the important roles people play in keeping our society safe and happy. ### Math Activities

The students explored the concepts of less than (<), greater than (>) and equals to (=) using numbers, objects, and playful comparisons. They especially enjoyed acting out the "hungry alligator" who always eats the bigger number, making the lesson fun and memorable.

They also practiced basic addition such as 2+2, 4+4, and 5+5, proudly sharing their answers and discovering the joy of combining numbers in different ways.

### Art and Craft Activities

Our students had a delightful time during Art and Craft as they colored pictures of different community helpers such as soldiers, doctors, artists, firefighters, and bus drivers. The children were enthusiastic as they brought these helpers to life with bright colors, proudly showing their work. The activity not only encouraged creativity but also helped the students appreciate the important roles these helpers play in our community.
