

Phonics Activities

This term, our A3 student have been exploring the sounds of the letters M, A, S, D, T, I, E, H, and O through songs, chants, and engaging activities. One highlight was the "Sound and Show" game, where students matched sounds to pictures like monkey, milk, sun, and socks, acting out the sounds with excitement. The activity was filled with laughter and helped the student build confidence as they proudly demonstrated their growing phonics knowledge.

Transportation




