Language Arts

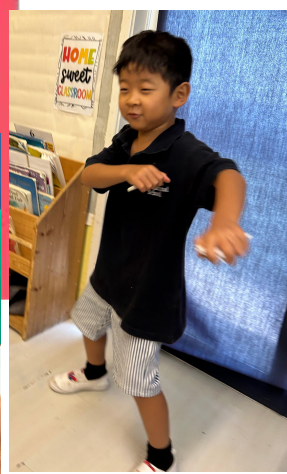
