WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL

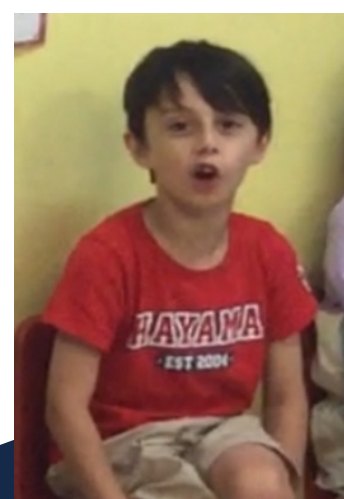
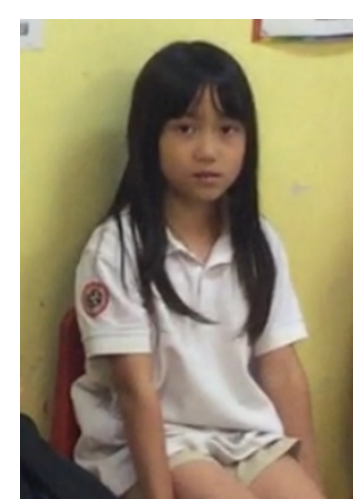
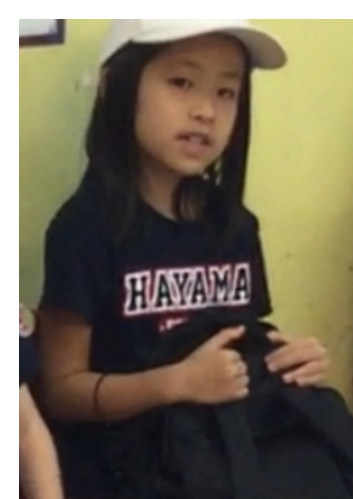
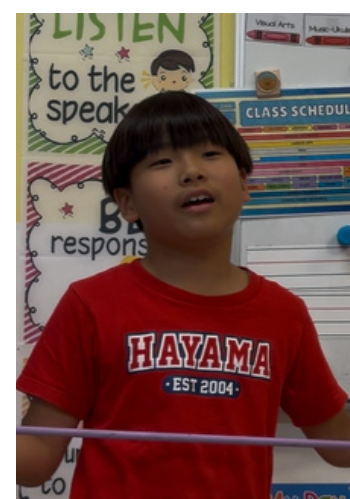

OUR ACADEMICS
