Our learners had a wonderful month filled with creativity, exploration, and growth!

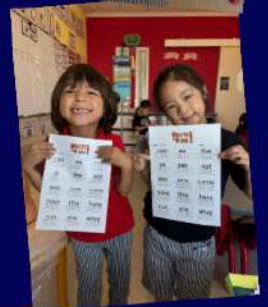
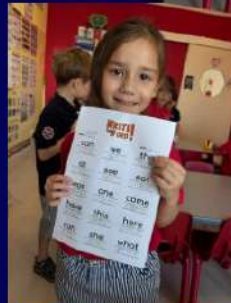
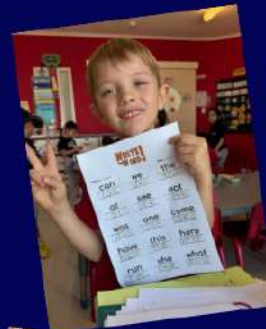
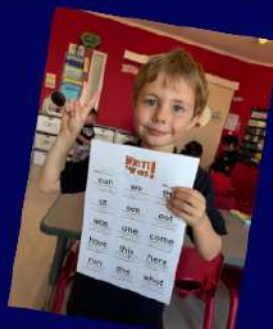
- In Language Arts, the children learned about word families in a fun and creative way. They drew trees and made colorful paper leaves, writing different word families on each one to show what they've learned. They also practiced sight words, focusing on reading and recognizing 4–5 letter words. During writing time, the students worked on improving their handwriting, spacing, and writing short and meaningful sentences with confidence.
- In Mathematics, our young learners practiced comparing numbers using greater than, less than, and equal to symbols. They also worked on ordering and completing number sequences using visuals and manipulatives. The class continued counting by 2s and started learning to count by 3s as they strengthened their understanding of numbers.
- During PSPE, the children had so much fun practicing for their Halloween dance performance! They enjoyed learning their dance steps, moving to the beat, and expressing themselves through rhythm and teamwork.
- A special highlight of the month was the Fire Prevention Class with the Yokosuka City Firefighters. The children learned about fire safety, saw real firefighting tools up close, and discovered how to stay calm and safe during emergencies.

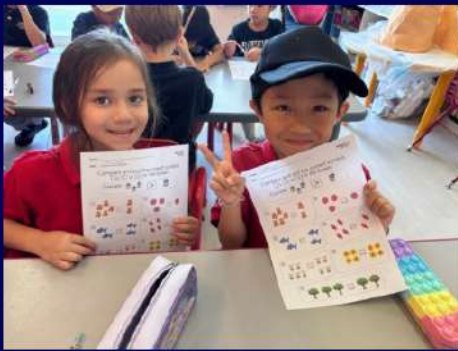
