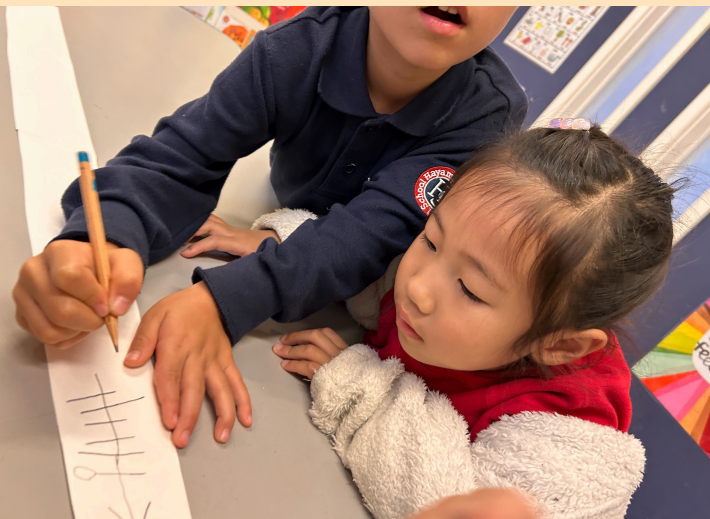

MATH

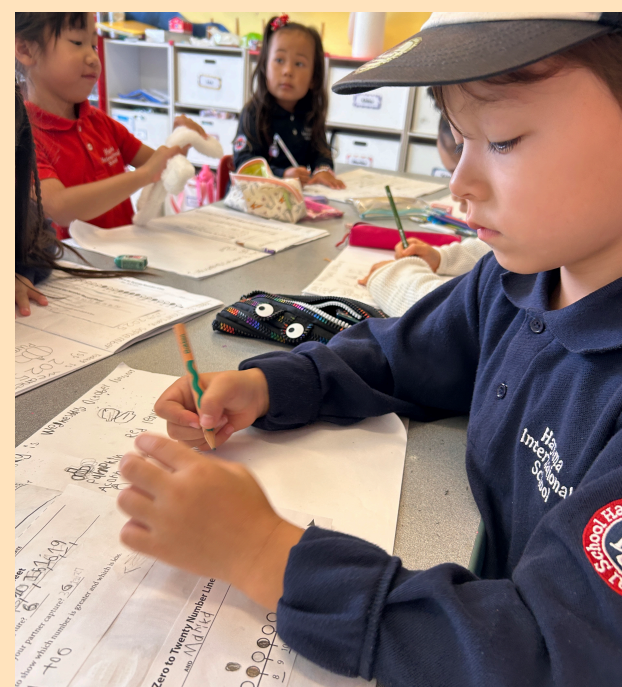
We are sharpening our listening and understanding skills through story problems, we experiment with various ways a single question can be answered, including how to show our thought processes on paper.



UOW

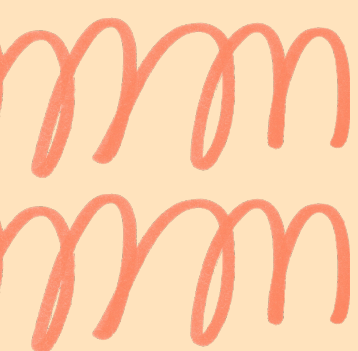
