#### **Phonics Activities**

This term, our A3 students also strengthened their pronunciation skills by learning the phonics sounds /c/, /u/ and /k/. Through lively songs, fun chants, and picture cards, the children explored words beginning with these sounds. For C, they practiced saying words like carrot, cap, candy, and cat, while for U we learnt Umbrella, Unicorns, and Uniform. and for K, they enjoyed Knight, Kite, Knee, King, Kitten, Kettle, and Kid. The children were eager to repeat the sounds, act them out, and connect them with real-life objects. This activity not only improved their articulation but also built their confidence in recognizing and using new sounds in everyday words.

#### **Transportation**

The students were excited to welcome the beginning of the fall season! Together, we talked about the changes we see during this time of year the cooler weather, falling leaves, and the beautiful colors of red, orange, and yellow. The children shared their own experiences of autumn, from spotting pumpkins to wearing cozy clothes. Through songs, stories, and creative art activities, they learned that fall is a time of change, beauty, and new beginnings. The excitement in their voices showed how much they are looking forward to all the fun this season will bring!

#### Math Activities

Through fun activities, hands-on materials, and group practice, the children gained more confidence in recognizing number patterns and understanding how addition helps us make sense of the world around us.
