

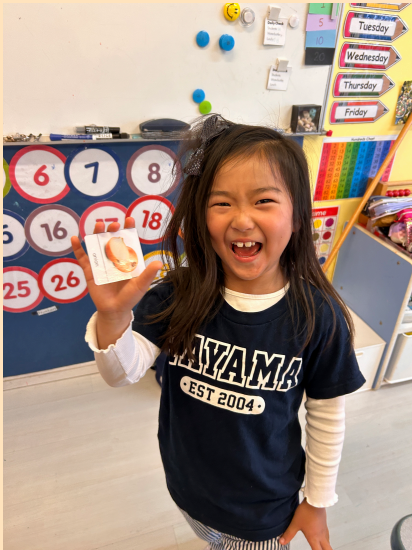

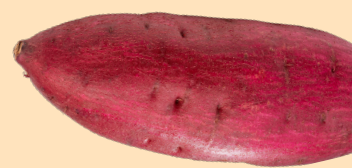

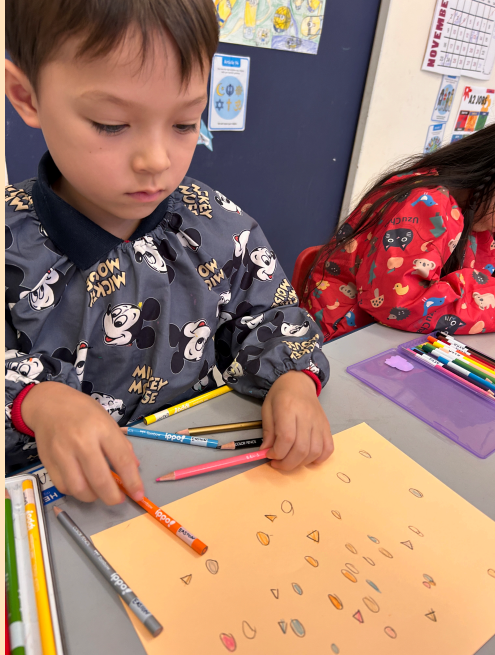

MATH

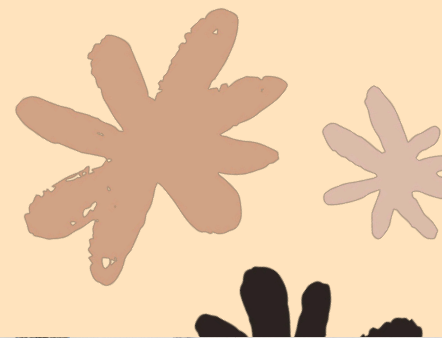
Continuing our listening and visualizing skills through more complex story problems. Working in groups, explaining our process, and putting them on paper.





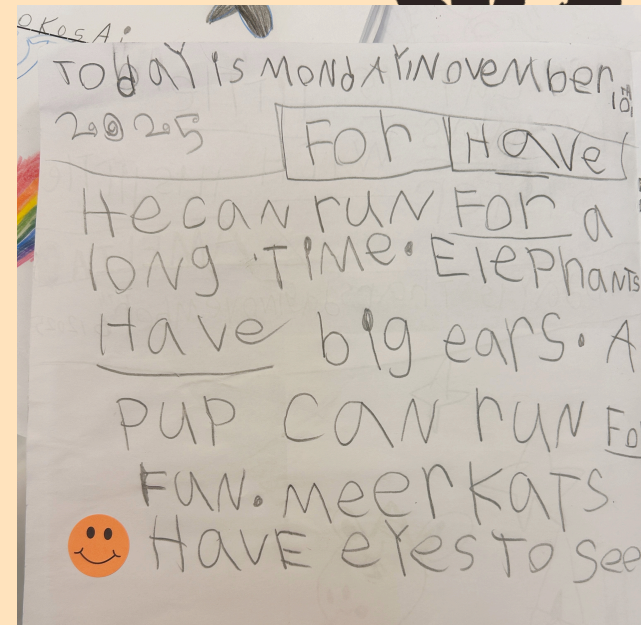
UOW
