

Phonics Activities

This week, our A3 students had fun learning the phonics sounds /e/ and /f/! Through songs, chants, and games, they practiced saying and identifying words that begin with these sounds. For E, they learned egg, elephant, and engine, while for F, they enjoyed fish, fan, flower, and frog etc. The students loved using pictures and real objects to connect each sound to everyday things around them. These activities helped strengthen their pronunciation, listening, and confidence in using new sounds.

Harvesting! Fruit and Vegetable Season

The students were excited to learn all about fruits and vegetables this week! Together, we talked about how they grow, their colors, and why they help us stay strong and healthy. The students enjoyed naming their favorite fruits and vegetables, sorting them by color and type, and discovering which ones grow above or below the ground.

During our activities, they created fun fruit-and-vegetable crafts, sang songs, and played sorting games that made learning even more enjoyable. Through these hands-on experiences, the students gained a better understanding of healthy eating and the importance of harvest season. What a colorful and nutritious week it was in A3!

Math Activities

The students explored patterns this week! They learned how patterns are sequences that repeat, such as shapes, colors, and numbers that follow a special order. Using beads, blocks, and number cards, the students created their own repeating patterns and identified those they saw around the classroom. They were excited to discover how patterns help us make predictions and recognize order in everyday life. Through fun, hands-on activities, the students built a stronger understanding of number patterns and logical thinking.

Art and Craft Activities

The students had a wonderful time creating their "Grape, Tomato and Corn Craft" during Art and Craft! Using colored paper, glue, and crayons, they carefully designed bunches of grapes, tomato and bright yellow corn to celebrate the harvest season. The classroom buzzed with excitement and creativity as the students proudly displayed their colorful work.
