Language Arts

Over the past two weeks, we focused on the letters Uu and Vv. The children practiced recognizing each letter's name and sound, matching initial sounds with pictures, and connecting uppercase and lowercase forms. They also traced and wrote Uu and Vv, learned new vocabulary beginning with these letters, and enjoyed creating our letter crafts: U is for Umbrella and V is for Volcano.

Mathematics

Over the past two weeks, we worked on numbers 11 and 12, practiced recognizing and counting them, and continued exploring simple patterns. We also spent time reviewing previous concepts to strengthen understanding and confidence.
