PUBLIC SPEAKING

For Creative Arts, we focused on building natural self-expression and confidence. The children wrote simple and personal descriptions connected to their photos, which helped them talk about their experiences in a more relaxed and natural way. This activity allowed them to express their own stories instead of memorizing lines, and it really improved their comfort when speaking in front of a group. They practiced maintaining eye contact, sharing with a steady voice, and supporting each other during presentations. OUR ACADEMICS
